#### NOTES FROM THE BOARD

- Natural Grasses & Natural Growth— We ask that you do not trim the areas near the bank of our lake. We have directed Milosi to also not trim this area in an attempt to allow regrowth and naturalization of the lake edge areas. This will improve the health of the lake, and prevent further erosion. Please contact any Board member if you wish to discuss this project further.
- **Parking** As a reminder, no parking is allowed on any of our streets overnight. Please park in your parking spaces, garage and driveway, or in overflow spots.
- **Property Management** Associa will be our new property management company beginning October 1. You will receive a letter from them with instructions on: 1. Payment information and addresses; 2. Accessing the website and App
- **Financials** Halo will stop drafting payments from your account. You will need to sign up for the Associa draft if you wish to utilize it. If you pay through your bank, please update your payment information when you receive the information from Associa.
- Architectural & Landscaping If you need a form, please contact a Board member. We should have them up on our new website sometime in October. Please submit your requests to Marilyn, who will forward them to the Committee and then the Board for review.
- **Upgraded Street Lights** NES has updated the remaining street lights we had with LED lights. These are brighter, last longer, and use less energy. It is a "whiter" light, so it may take a bit getting used to, but the increased brightness is very nice.
- Neighborhood Watch There will not be an October meeting, but please mark you calendar for November 1. This will be a special meeting that will be devoted to "Active Shooter Training". MNPD has conducted this training for us in the past and it is excellent. The training will increase your awareness and how to respond if you become involved in an active shooter situation. Don't forget to bring your neighbor.
